COMMUNITY SERVICES \$2,148,000


Catholic Charities assists people of all faiths with a wide range of services including:

- Individual and Family Counseling to assist with emotional and relationship issues.
- Pregnancy Support for expectant mothers and newborns.
- Community Support Services to assist with employment issues and emergency needs.
- Housing Services that make safe and stable homes available for individuals and families.
- Older Adult Services and Adult Day Care create safe and caring environments to help seniors remain independent.
- Catholic Senior Housing and Healthcare Services, Holy Family Manor, and Holy Family Residence provide quality physical, emotional, social and spiritual care with dignity and compassion to meet the needs of older adults in our community.
- Health care and housing for Retired and Infirmed Priests who are in good standing.

PARISH LIFE **\$423,000**

Your support provides parishes with tools to implement faith development in the daily activities of our lives and supports outreach to Catholics who are inactive or alienated. Pastoral services supported by the Bishop's Annual Appeal include:

VOCATIONS \$428,000

Support of the Appeal ensures that, through the generous ministry of our ordained clergy, members of our diocesan family will continue to share the Light of Christ as part of a dynamic faith community.

PARISH SHARING \$355,000

Funds for parishes that meet or exceed Bishop's Annual Appeal goals.

ADMINISTRATION \$300,000

Only 6 percent of funds raised by the Appeal are used for Administrative expenses which includes design, printing, and distribution of Bishop's Annual Appeal materials to over 251,000 Catholics.
